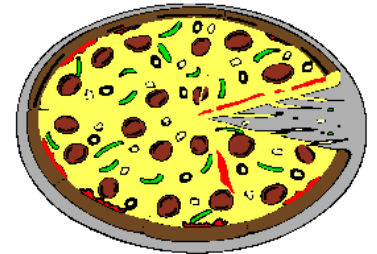
Peanut Butter Play-dough Recipe
