The Webelos were to participate in a Troop "patrol" setting, and get a glimpse of what it will be like to part of a Boy Scout Troop campout/outing. Friday night consisted of setting up the lighting, dining flies, patrol boxes, and troop tents, all arranged in a patrol setting. They held an evening "camp fire", complete with songs, skits (Boy Scouts have interesting ones), and fellowship, then off to bed by 10:00. Saturday morning came early, with the scouts learning and easy way to make a breakfast egg burrito.
